



Cookie Policy

Read alongside our Privacy Policy.

Cookies are small text files that a website stores on your device so it can remember things between pages and visits. Some are needed for our site to work and to keep our forms safe. Others are optional, and we only use them if you agree to them.

This policy explains the cookies we use on azuriteinnovation.com, what each one does, and how you can control them. It sits alongside our Privacy Policy, which explains more about how we handle personal data.

Your choices

When you first visit, a banner lets you accept or reject the optional cookies, or set your preferences by category. Until you choose, only the strictly necessary cookies are set-nothing optional loads before you accept. If you leave the optional cookies off, the site works exactly the same; we just see less about how it is used.

You can change your choice any time from the cookie settings link in the footer. Turning a category off stops new cookies being set in it. Cookies already stored aren't deleted automatically-you can clear those at any time through your browser.

Strictly necessary cookies

These are needed for the site to work and to protect it. They don't require your consent and can't be turned off through the banner, but they don't track what you do around the rest of the web.

Cloudflare Turnstile cookie	Cloudflare	Set when a form loads, to tell real visitors from bots and protect our forms from automated abuse. Holds no data.	Session

Statistics cookies

These help us understand how the site is used-which pages people read, and where they arrive from-so we can improve it. We use Google Analytics. They are off until you accept them, and turning them off doesn't change how the site works for you.

Cookie	Set by	What it does	Expires
_ga	Google	Tells one visitor apart from another.	13 months

Cookie	Set by	What it does	Expires
_ga_GNN5GT9MDL	Google	Keeps track of a single visit for our analytics.	13 months

If you later withdraw consent, these two cookies stay on your device until they expire or you clear them- turning statistics off stops new data being collected, but doesn't delete cookies already set.

Marketing cookies

We embed a Google Map on our About and Contact pages. The map only loads if you accept marketing cookies; until then it stays hidden behind a placeholder. When it loads, Google sets its own cookies through google.com. We don't run any advertising or retargeting.

Cookie	Set by	What it does	Expires
NID	Google	Set when the Google Map loads, after you accept marketing cookies. Google uses it to remember your preferences.	6 months

Managing cookies in your browser

As well as our banner, you can manage or delete cookies through your browser settings, and set most browsers to warn you before a cookie is stored. If you block strictly necessary cookies, parts of the site- including our forms- may stop working properly.

Third parties and international transfers

Google and Cloudflare set some of the cookies described above. They may process limited technical data outside the European Economic Area. Where that happens, we rely on an adequacy decision by the European Commission, or on appropriate safeguards such as its standard contractual clauses. This is covered in section 7 of our Privacy Policy.

Changes to this policy

We may update this policy from time to time- for example, if we change the tools we use. When we do, we'll change the "last updated" date at the top.
